About Me In The Bath

Me In The Bath is the one man band formed in 2010 by Nicolas Chartoire (Gorbie's Stuff, Still Living Creature, ...), mixing lofi noise and garage sound with conventional pop harmonies and song structures. Rapidly spotted at the avant-garde of the internet scene, the fame of the project, while still quite underground, went always further and further, with many radio appearances, compilation featurings, covers made by other bands and all the things alike. Like the album said, « We Ain't Got Time », and Me In The Baths is recording quickly, issuing literally dozens of dozens of songs since the begining, in a full DIY spirit and far away from mass media.

About Crem Road records

Operated since the late 90's as an informal collective, the aim of Crem Road records ever since is to provide free music to the people. Fully independent, providing the sound (and videos, and for a long while physical releases) straight on its site toward the audience, Crem Road records also maintains and gives back to the community the code base used by it, allowing any label needing to set up a website to use the code. With major artists like Didjaws, The Big Circus Project, Silence International or naturally Me In The Bath, Crem Road records is undoubdtly an undodgeable label for anyone interested by the internet scene.
